



City Orientation Tour

Depart at 08:30am **PICKUP** at the CTICC.

Cape Town is Africa's most popular tourist destination and is hailed as one of the most beautiful cities in the world. So come and experience the modern-day Capetonian life with us, while dibbing back in time as we visit a few of the cities numerous historic treasures.

Our journey begins with **Table Mountain**. Enjoy the crisp air as you reach the summit (weather permitting and cable car for own account +/- R245pp). One of the New 7 Wonders of Nature, Table Mountain forms a natural amphitheatre around the city which is what makes it unique, beautiful and dramatic!

Thereafter we'll make our way into the city down below to explore its rich and diverse history. Starting with the **Company Gardens** where you'll get to enjoy a walk in this beautiful heritage site originally created in the 1650s (and possibly meet some inquisitive squirrels).

We then visit the **St George's Cathedral**, also known as the "People's Cathedral" for its role in the resistance against apartheid. It is the oldest cathedral in Southern Africa.

The tour continues with a drive past the **Houses of Parliament, the Slave Lodge, City Hall**, and onto the **Castle of Good Hope** to explore the oldest existing colonial building in South Africa.

Next it's onto the **District Six Museum**. The District Six Foundation was founded in 1989 and the museum in 1994, as a memorial to the forced movement of 60,000 inhabitants of various races in District Six during Apartheid in South Africa in the 1970s. Then it's onto **Green Market Square**. Greenmarket Square is a historical square in the centre of old Cape Town. Built in 1696, it has served as a slave market, a vegetable market, and more recently, a "Flea Market" trading mainly African Souvenirs, crafts and curios.

Lastly, we end off with a visit to the colourful "**Bo Kaap**", also known as the Malay quarter. The architecture in this area is typical of what Cape Town was like 200 years ago.
